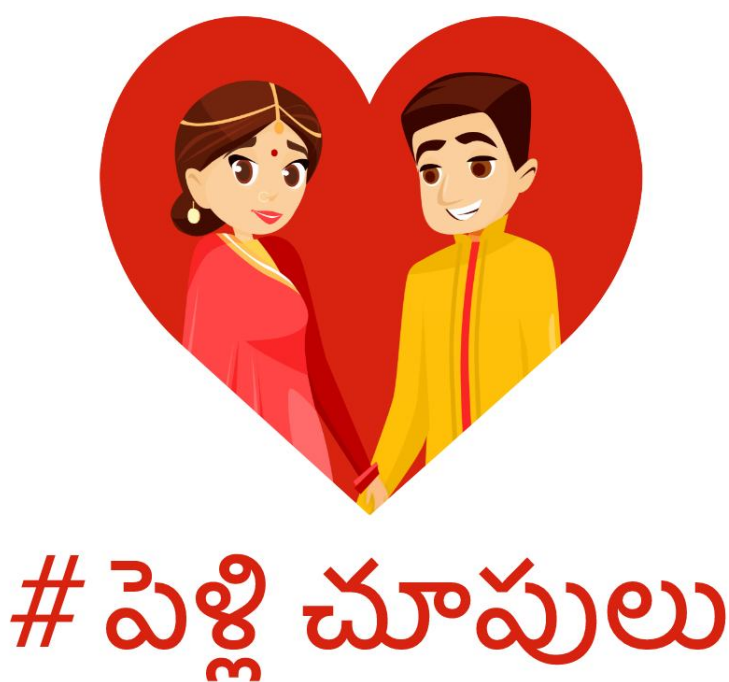


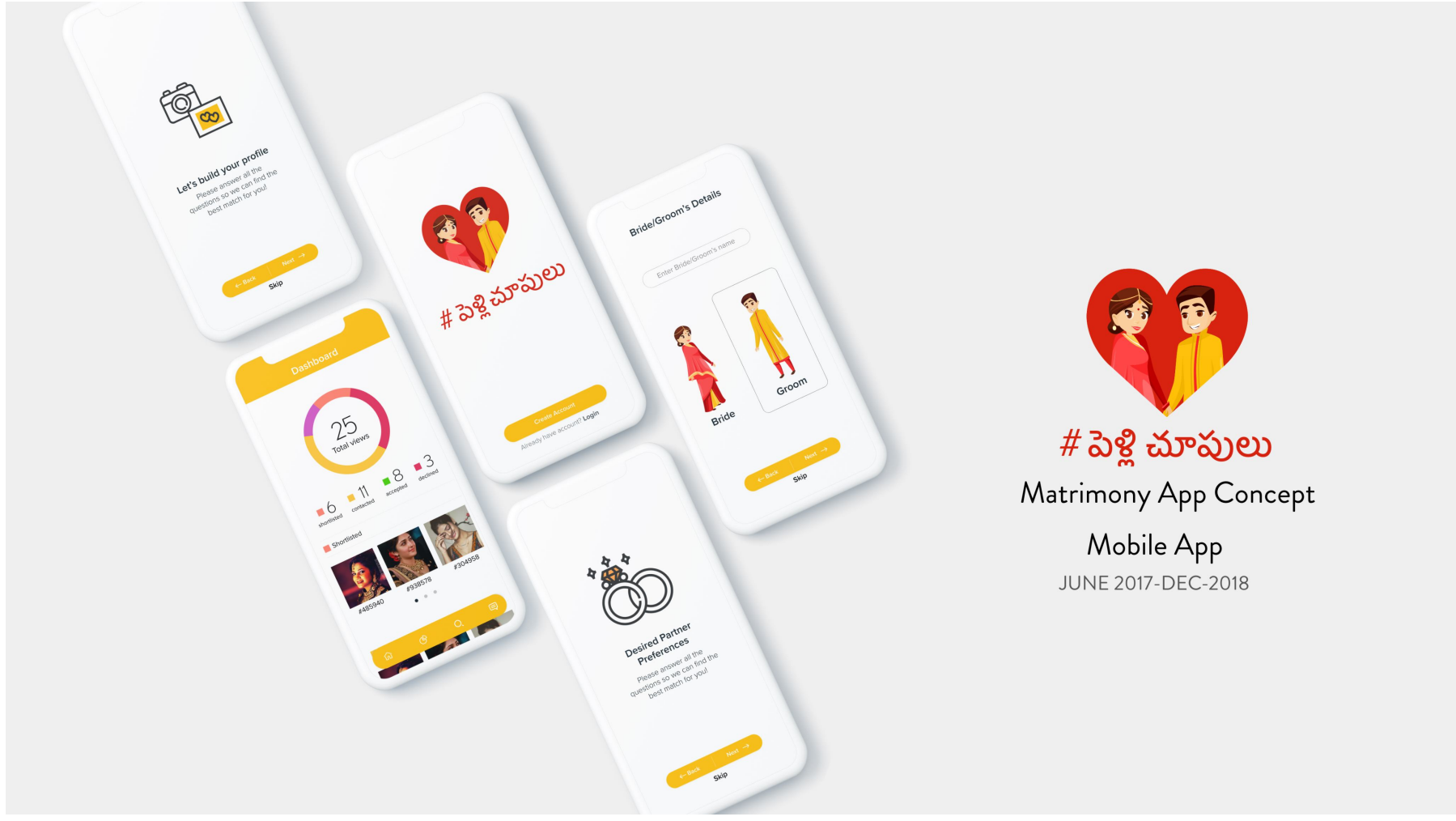
Pelli Choopulu Case Study

The current matrimony apps in the market have a terrible user experience. We wanted to create this matrimony app with a minimalistic and elegant approach. The app has a beautiful user interface and a very user-friendly navigation. The unique thing about this app is it's dashboard, which instantly shows stats like who have accepted the user's requests, who have declined, who have visited the user's profile, who has sent an invitation to meet. It also has messaging feature to initiate a conversation with the people the user picks on the app. It also has a very elegant and user-friendly way of helping the user build it's profile step by step and also add their partner preferences very easily. The main audience for this app are parents who are looking the perfect match for their kids, so we can assume the target audience is above 40's. 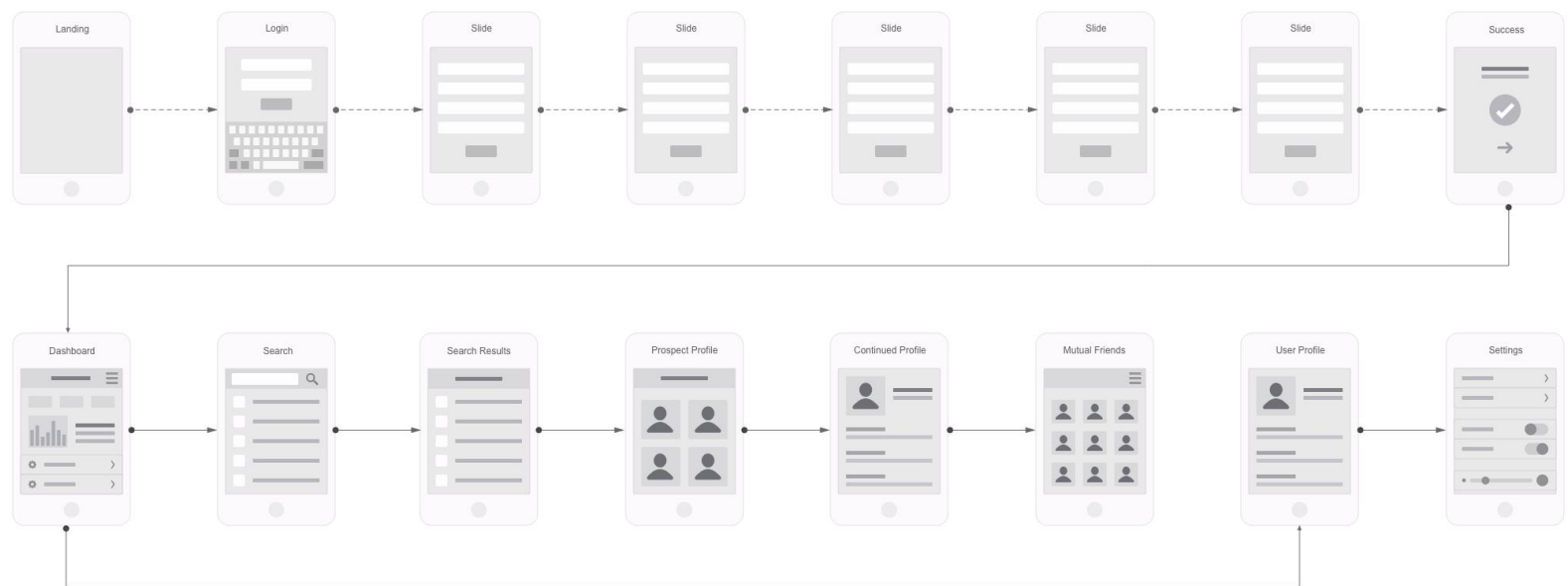
