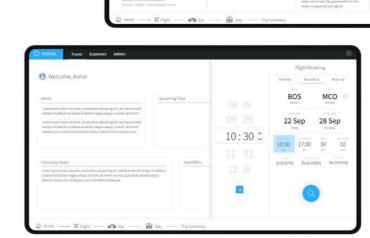
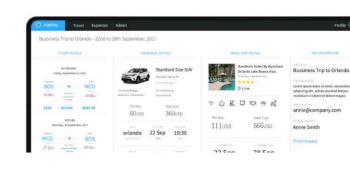

-Has a hard time tracking approvals for his travel.

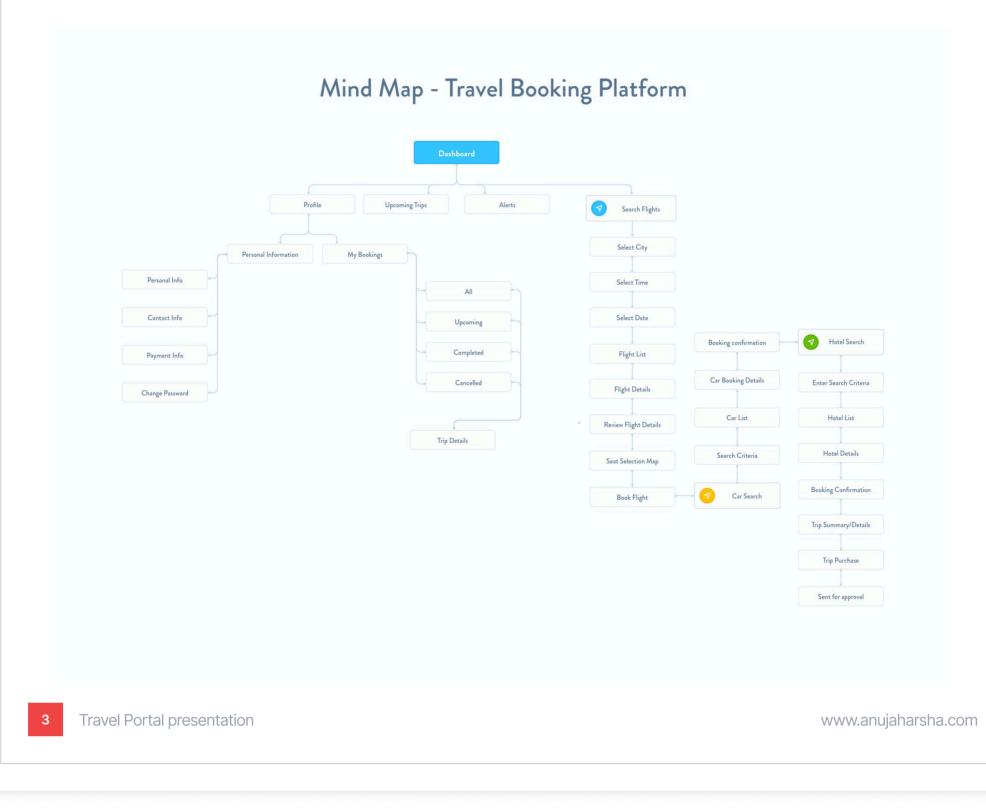

content organization. Mind maps help visualize relationships between different sections and establish a logical navigation hierarchy.



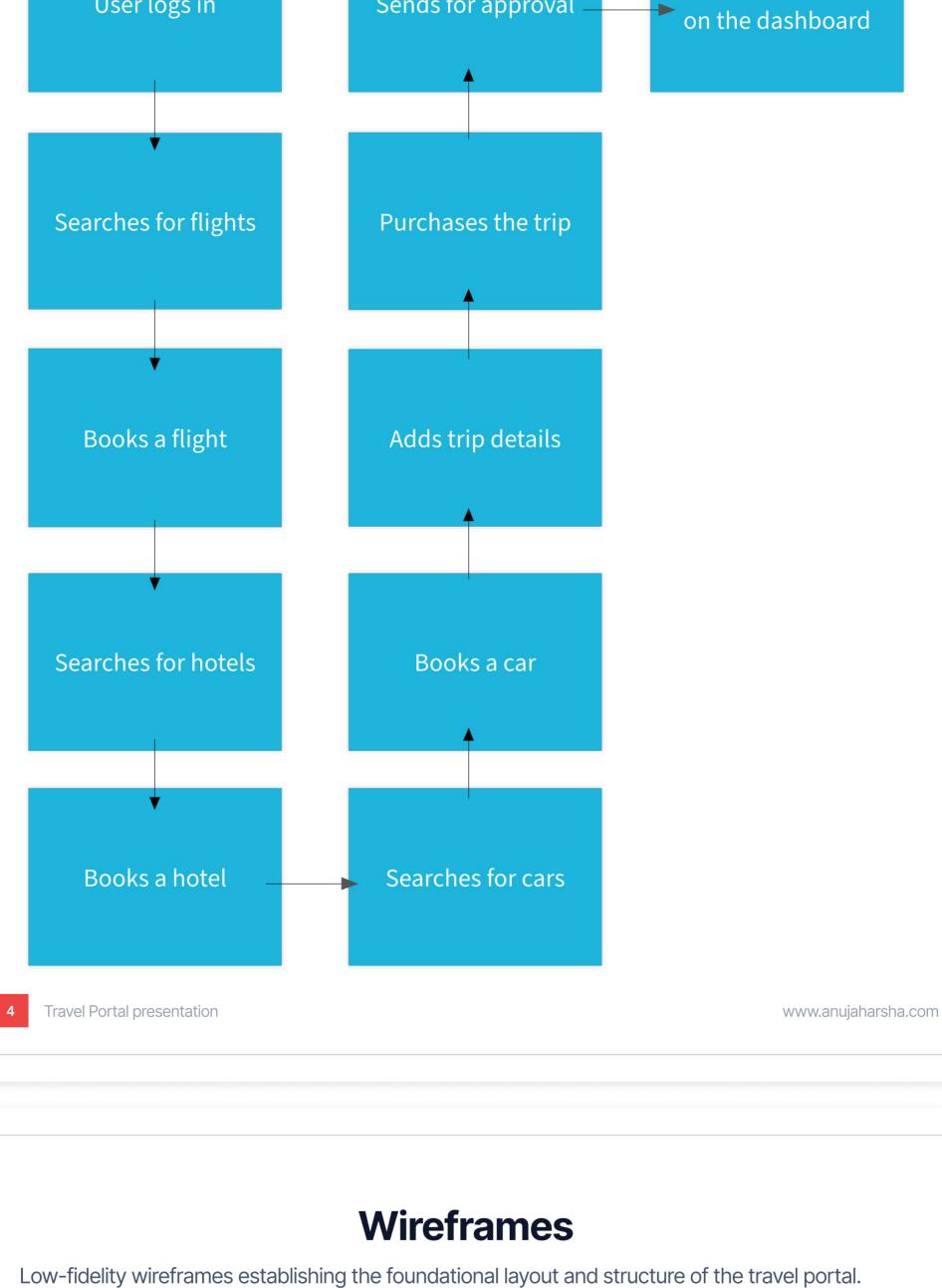

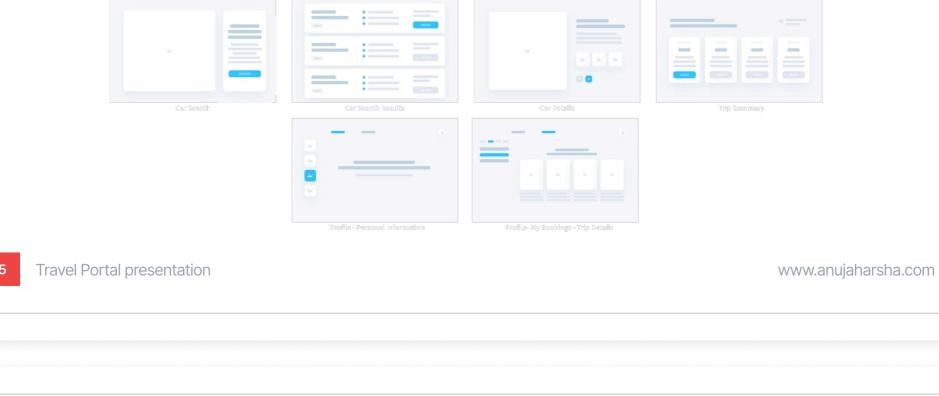

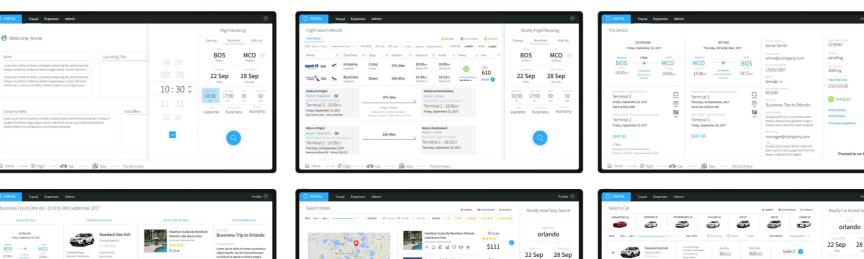
